A notice of appeal in the above cause has been filed. This appeal has been docketed in the Appellate Court as appeal number 1-23-2221.

Supreme Court Rule 312 requires the appellant to complete and file a docketing statement with proof of service and pay the \$50 filing fee within 14 days of the filing of the notice of appeal. A copy of the written request(s) to the Court Reporter(s) asking for preparation of the report(s) of proceeding(s) must be attached to the docketing statement when filed in the Appellate Court.

If the appellant is indigent and unable to pay the \$50 filing fee, a request for waiver of the filing fee must be submitted at the time the docketing statement is filed. If approved by the Appellate Court, the waiver of filing fee applies only to the \$50 Appellate Court filing fee and does not address the fees for preparation of the record on appeal by the Circuit Court Clerk, reports of proceedings, or any other costs incurred in litigation of the appeal.
