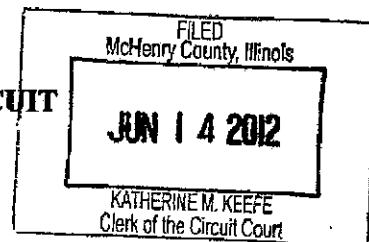

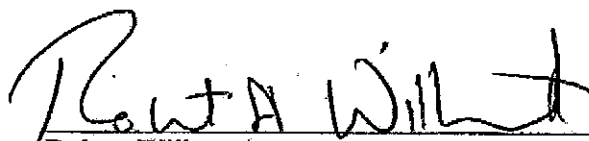
**ORDER ISSUING MITTIMUS ON ADJUDICATION OF INDIRECT CIVIL
CONTEMPT**

This cause has come on to be heard on issuance of mittimus on the court's finding of indirect civil contempt against Defendant Thomas Popovich pursuant to the court's adjudication order of May 24, 2012 and subsequent orders, the court being unaware of any stay of mittimus:

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Husband is committed to the McHenry County Jail, there to remain until he has purged himself of contempt by paying to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of McHenry County the sum of \$60,000 on behalf of Wife for transfer to attorney Schwarz, or until Husband is otherwise discharged by due process of law. The court will review the sentence after 30 days of incarceration at a time to be set upon further order.
