6. Dulberg made another discovery that On June 13, 2016, in violation of an automatic stay, without leave from the Honorable Judge Thomas M. Lynch adjudicating BK No. 14-83578 for the 7th Circuit United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Western Division and without being hired as special counsel by the appointed and then current Bankruptcy Trustee Heeg, Allstate attorney Reddington and the Baudin Defendants were moving forward in the Illinois 22nd Judicial Circuit Court, Case No. 12LA178.

Plaintiff's attorney and I are working on the case to see if it's a possible ADR candidate. He asked that we get our motions entered and continued. They're for an IME." Allstate attorney Reddington also said, "And honestly, if I get a decision sooner, that -- well, I don't know if this is a case we -- we probably wouldn't be able to enter a dismissal order if we went to ADR until after the ADR was done."
