Tom,

I did an exhaustive search and cannot locate a signed copy of the retainer/contract for legal services with the Clinton firm.

It doesn't mean that it doesn't exist in our records in the "Dulberg Master File" provided by the Clinton firm and here is why:

The agreement was printed out on paper, signed by me and mailed via the US post office back to the Clinton firm as paper.

This was done because at the time I hired the Clinton firm, I did not have a working scanner and had a limited number of days to hire new counsel, so it had to be done.

The agreement MAY have been scanned in by the Clinton firm and exists as a scanned picture without optical character recognition (OCR) being applied, meaning it is not searchable by the text within the document.

If it was scanned in as a picture it was not given a file name containing any of the the words retainer, contract or signed.

I have ran the entire "Dulberg Master File" through adobe's optical character recognition software (OCR) making all text found in pictures searchable and still cannot find a signed copy anywhere.

I strongly suspect the Clinton firm did not provide us a copy of the signed contract/retainer agreement when they withdrew and provided the case file named "Dulberg Master File".

It is unlikely but there is one more location a signed copy may still exist.

Mr Talarico received a separate copy of the "Dulberg Master File" directly from the Clinton firm, I believe on a thumb drive.

I doubt the Clinton firm provided Mr Talarico with a copy of the "Dulberg Master File" that has different files in it then those provided to me because we have never noticed a difference and have exhaustively been using the "Dulberg Master File" for a couple of years.

In the end, now knowing the complex issues the Clinton firm created by not providing all my documents to the opposing party until withdrawal and the complete hiding of a single document, the Tilschner slip ruling, I suspect that Clinton firm purposely did not provide us with a copy of the signed retainer/contract for legal services so we would have a tough time proving any actual retainer/contract for legal services ever existed.

I copied Mr Talarico in on this email so he can weigh in and say whether he has ever noticed a copy of the retainer/contract for legal services with the Clinton firm signed by me.
