Dear Attorney Strom,

I am in the middle of watching your ISBA Civil Appeal Basics "When is an Illinois Circuit Court Order Appealable?" but

I cannot determine which of the 3 of 4 attached orders are appealable

The first order entered on May 25, 2023 is clearly appealable and I have appealed 1-23—1142 but my Appellants' Brief is due on October 12, 2023.

The second order of May 25, 2023 is in question the Complaint was dismissed without prejudice.

The third order dated August 29, 2023 is in question because the Attorney for these Defendants said he did not want final and appealable language until the Allstate Defendants Motion was ruled upon .

The fourth order dated September 21, 2023 is in question based on the language of the order missing "and there is no just reason or cause to delay the enforcement of this order."

Add to the above the statements made as stated on the Report of Proceedings for September 21, 2023 page 1 line 9 to 17 where, when I was asked what i remember about the other parties and I responded incorrectly because I had forgotten about Defendant ADR Systems and the Judge said on the record that "Okay.
